

Renting Out Your Boat Slip



Listing your Slip for rent

- Email lhpcustomerservice@ehpm.ca to request your boat slip be listed on the Marina Slips page
- Please provide: slip number and contact information (phone number, email, or both)
- Optional: price requested and additional notes



Answering calls/Information re renting a slip

- Your first question to ask an inquirer: “Are you a resident of Lighthouse Point, and what is your unit number please?”
→ LHP is a private marina, and *only LHP residents may rent a slip*
- If Boat Slip holder lives at LHP, they retain the rights to the Marina outdoor pool and the Boathouse (if it is open for use).
 - If the Slip holder does not reside at LHP (their unit is rented out), access to all LHP amenities is forfeited
- Slip Renter is NOT permitted access to the Marina pool or the boathouse

Renting out your slip

- Owner is responsible for paying annual marina dues. A slip may be rented only when the fee has been paid.
 - Owner and renter agree on a price – the price requested and payment made are between the owner and the renter. When the owner is satisfied the funds have been received, please notify office that the rental may go ahead.
 - Forms required:
 - 1) Boat Slip Rental Registration (link on this page) – owner's unit number and signature are required to authorize the rental; slip renter completes the remainder of the form
 - 2) Watercraft insurance certificate in slip renter's name showing \$2 million liability
- Please submit these documents at least 2 business days prior to launch date in order to allow time for processing

At the end of the season

- Please note that ALL slip rentals end at the close of the season. If the slip is rented to the same person the subsequent year, please re-submit forms for the re-rental.
